Gardening Details

We provide you with:

- -nutrient rich soil and compost
- -a wood frame around your plot
- -modified garden beds for people with disabilities, and those in wheelchairs
- -water
- -access to a community garden tool shed and tools
- -gardening classes and workshops
- -garden coordinators, mentors, and a gardening community

Gardeners provide: personal gardening tools, organic soil amendments, seeds, elbow grease, enthusiasm, and a willingness to expand and share your gardening knowledge.

Plot Applications

Plot applications are available at the Creston Neighborhood Association or online at http://crestoncommunitygardens.org/registration

The rental cost for a garden plot is \$20 (+10 deposit) for a 10x10 ft. plot. There are scholarships available. An additional garden plot, if available, is \$5.

The \$10 deposit will be refunded to you following the clean up of your plot. If you wish to reserve your plot for the next growing season we will roll your \$10 deposit to secure it for you in the new year.
